TASTING NOTES

Deep garnet in color with bold aromas of game, wet slate, charcoal and boysenberry filling the nose and leading to a palate equally as rich. Mouth-filling flavors of baked plum and currant are accented by minerality and spice framed by rustic tannins, balancing acidity and a lingering fruit-driven finish.
