Pinot Gris was first introduced into the United States from France by David Lett, who planted Pinot Gris in the North Willamette Valley at The Eyrie Vineyards. Founder Jim Bernau got his first cuttings of Pinot Gris as a result of David's innovative work, and this wine is now Oregon's leading white variety.

#### TASTING NOTES

Aromas of honeydew melon, guava and mango. Citrus and tropical flavors on the palate.

#### FOOD PAIRINGS

Enjoy with Oregon Dungeness crab, angel hair pasta with shrimp, halibut in a lemon herb butter sauce, stir fry dishes and spring rolls.
